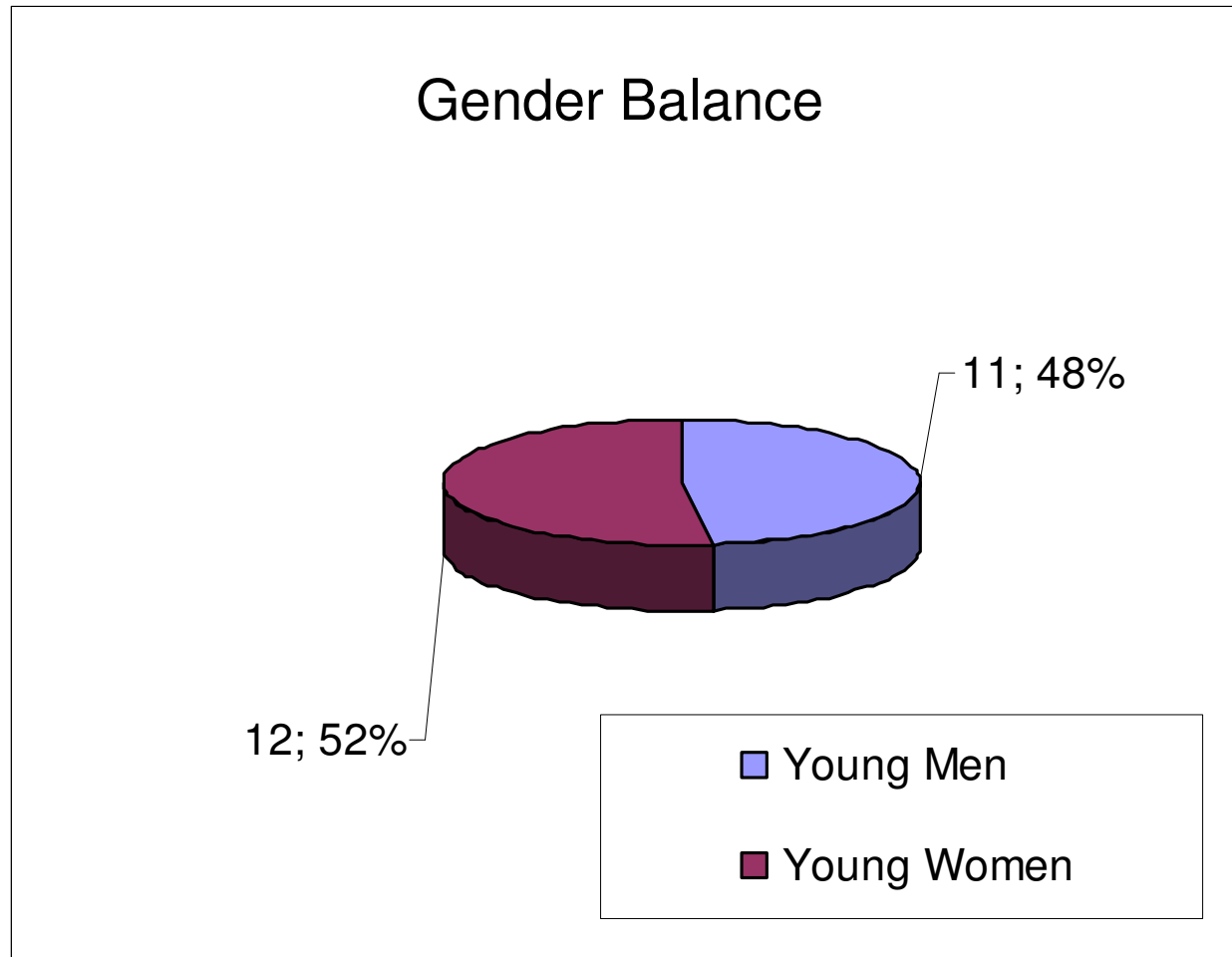

Introduction

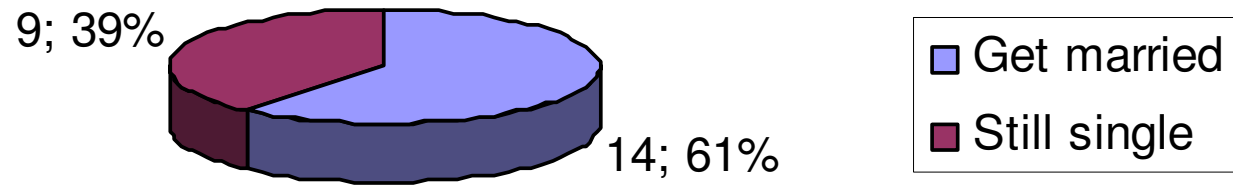
- The group of participants of the study is the same group which has participated at year-long life skills training held by INGO “Ponimanie” in Druya orphanage in 2002.
- During 2002-2008 the team of “Ponimanie” provided to participants with guidance and observed their achievements and issues.
- The number of participants is 23.
- The study is particular enough but giving the appropriate picture of usual level of socialization of young people leaving residential institutions for orphans having spent there 5 or more years.

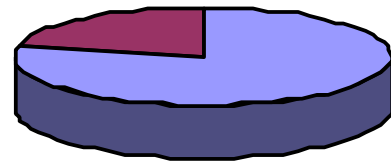

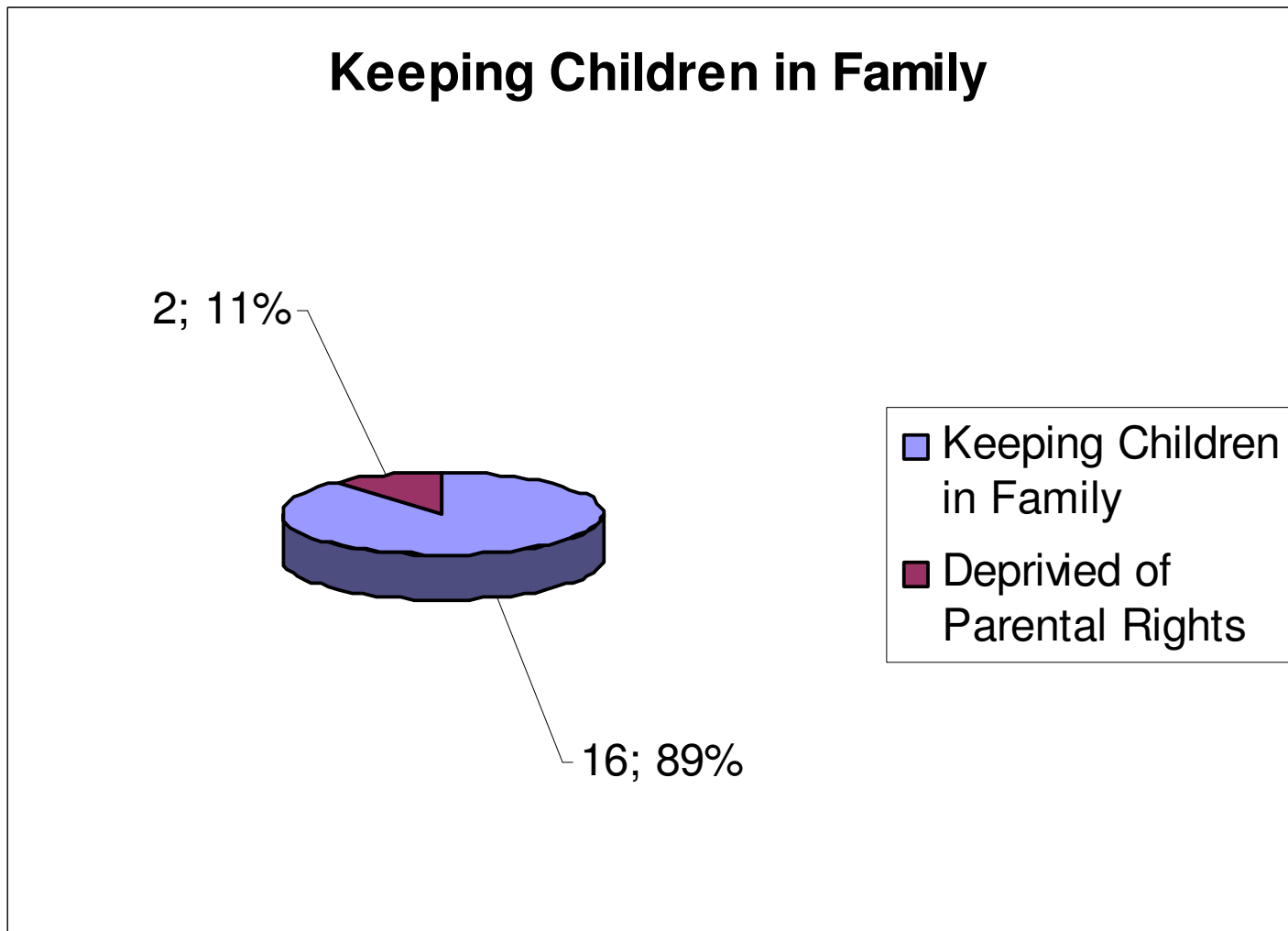

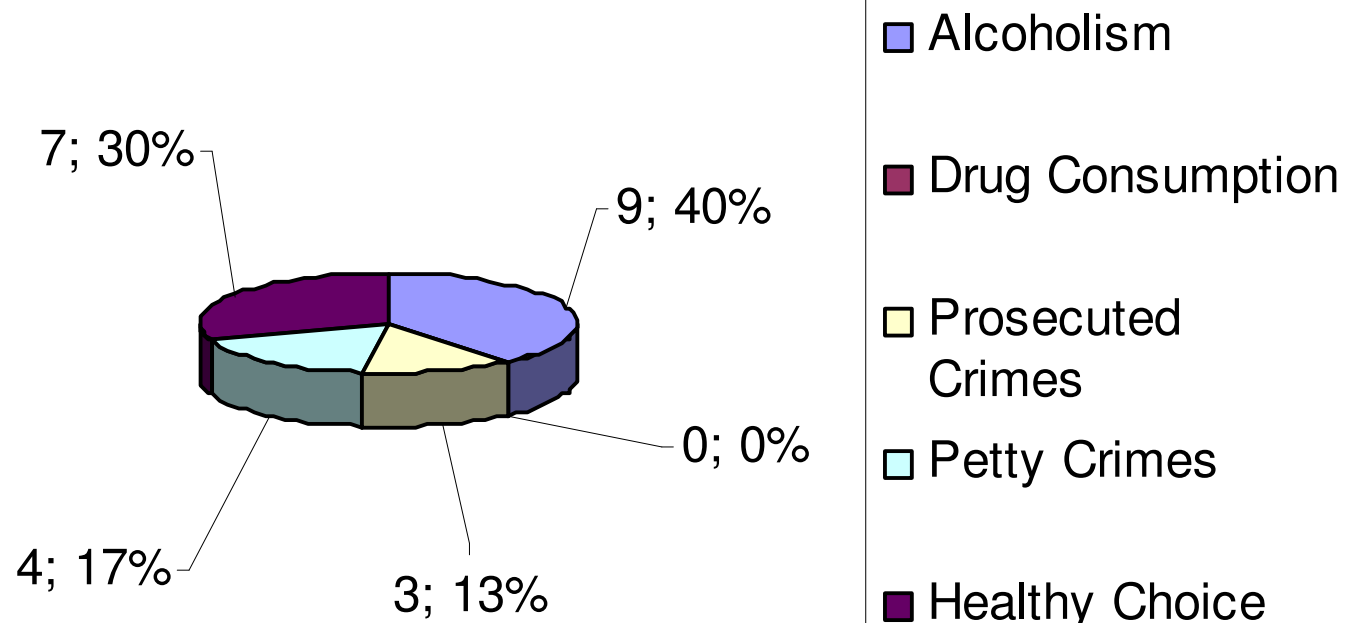

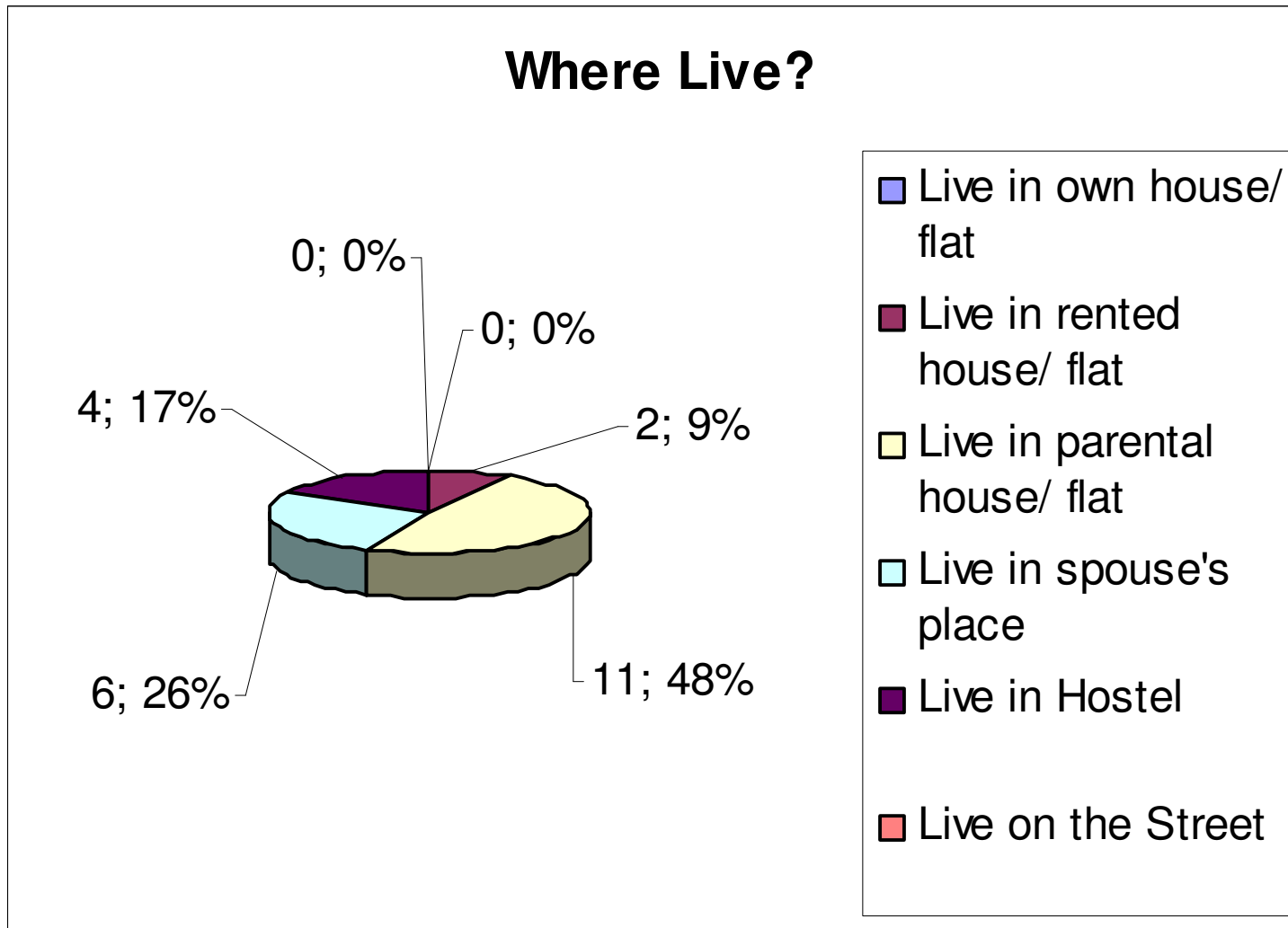


Participants' Lifestyle

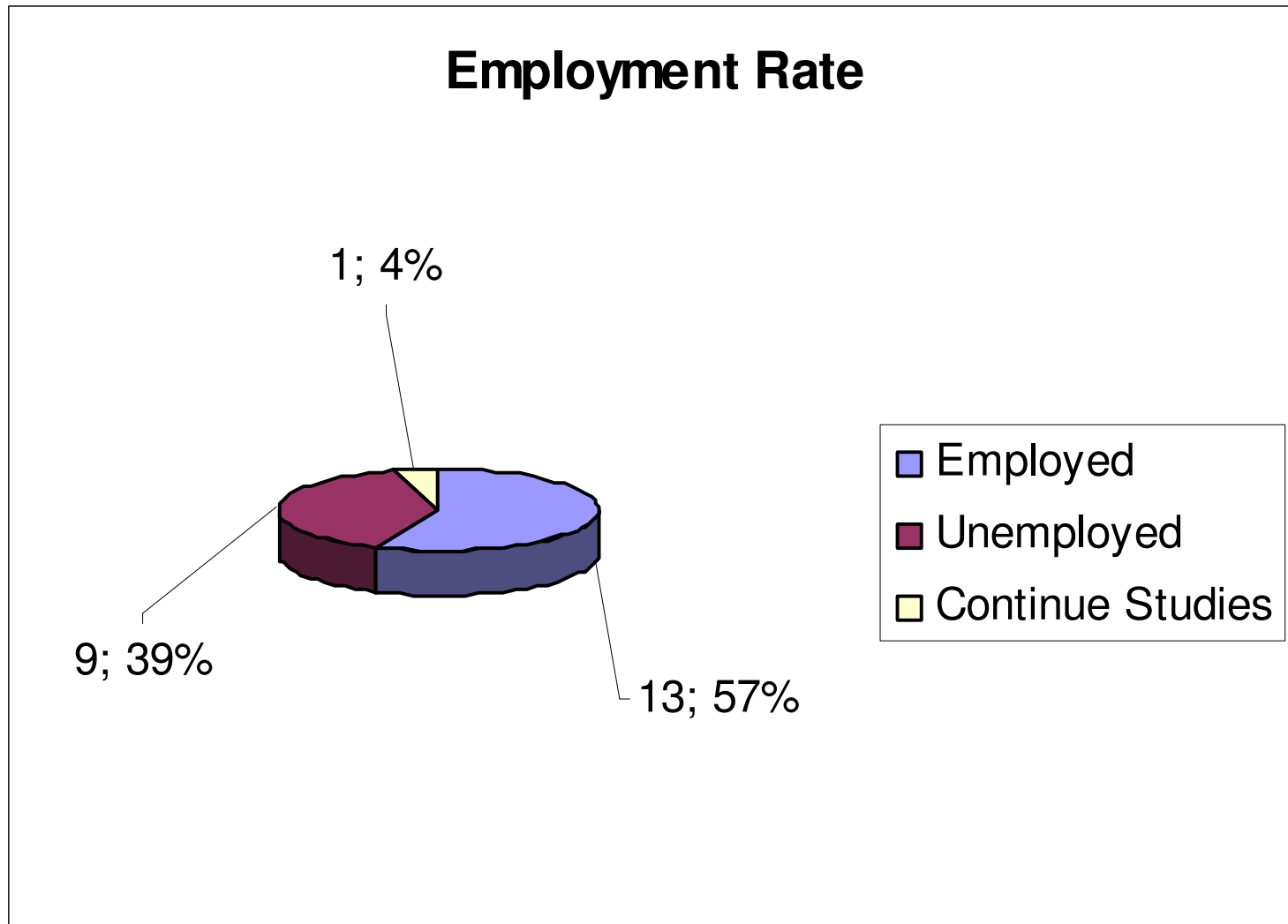
Alcoholism, Drugs, Crimes VS. Healthy Lifestyle



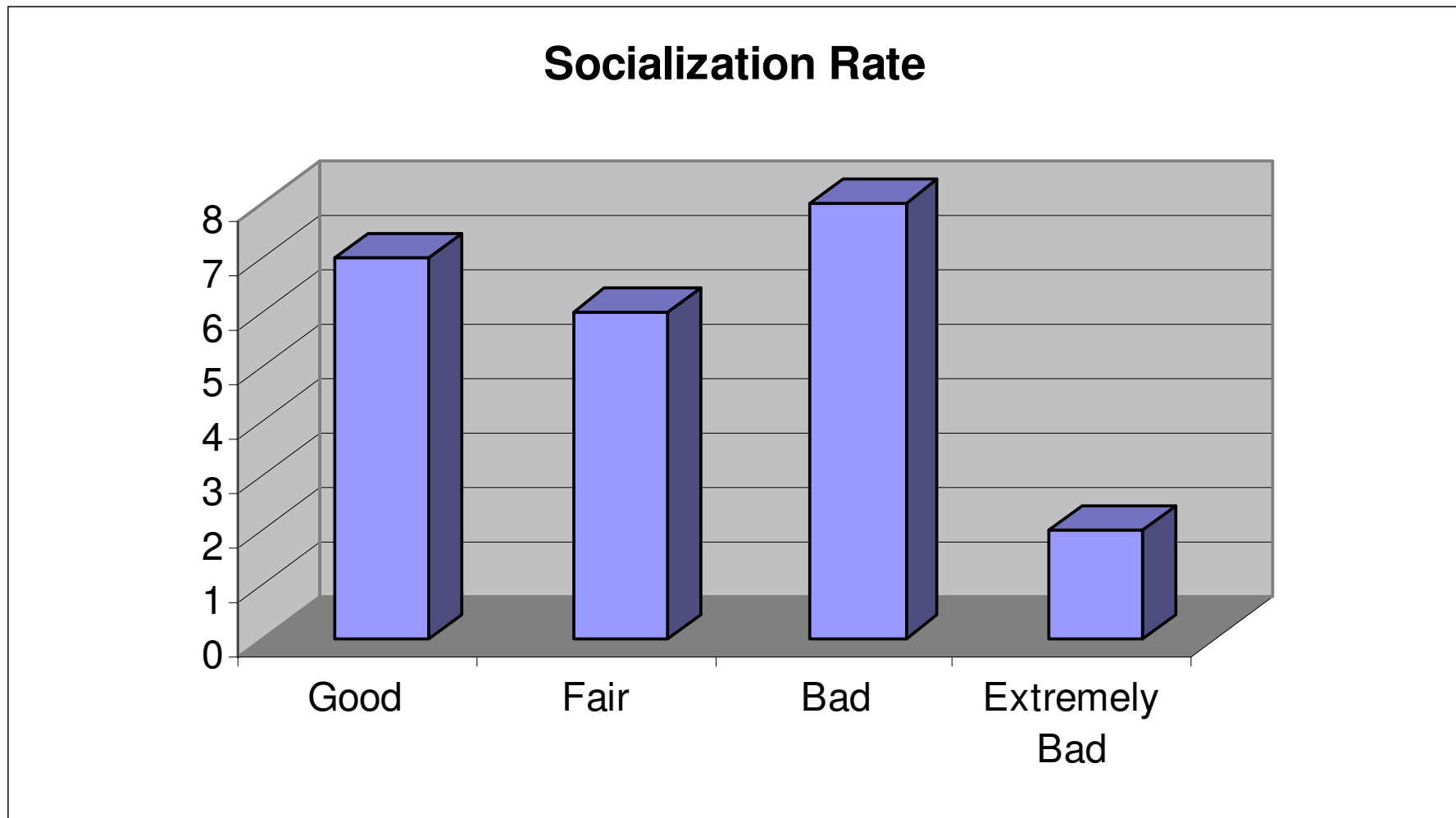
Keeping Own House or not?



What better? To earn or to beg?

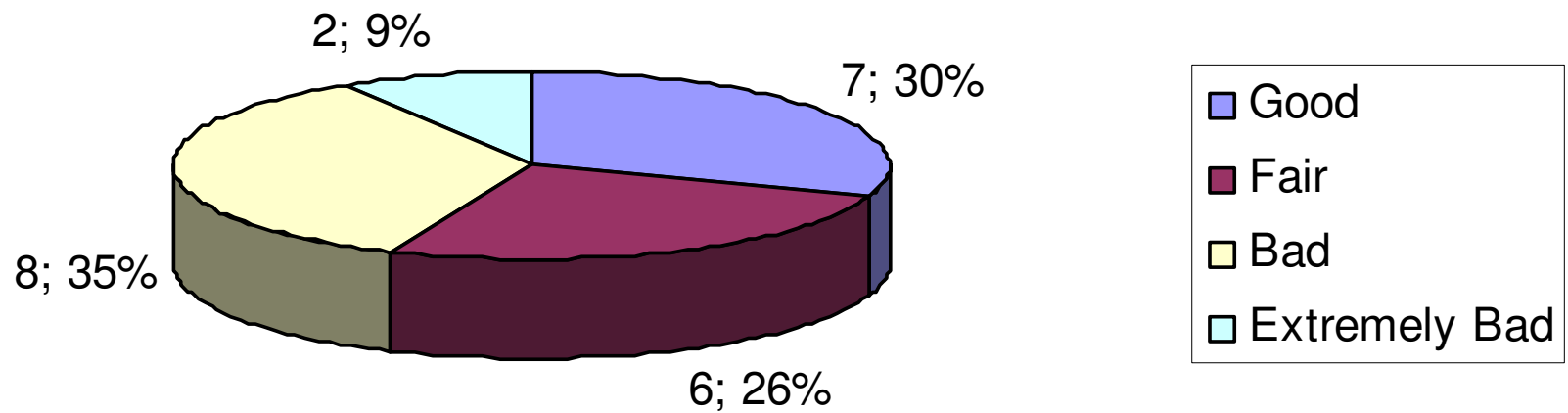


Bad or Good?

Conclusions

- One third participant only have demonstrated good rate of socialization in 6 years after leaving residential facility for orphans.
- One tenth participant was completely lumpenized.
- Comparison to 80% of good socialization of “family children” allows to conclude that governmental policy of deinstitutionalization of orphaned children is right but it needs in significant strengthening in 2011-15.
